PCH STRATEGIC/IMPLEMENTATION PLAN UPDATE

- **Quality Care** - New UltraSound purchased—thanks in large part to the Healthcare Foundation—and being used in the ER looking to develop outpatient bases. New 64 slice GE CT agreed on and going to be installed 6/5-6/12. Still working to get Healthy Choices to Medical staff to inform and discuss prevention programs available. Working on initiating our Antibiotic Stewardship program in partnership with DPHHS
- **Managing Population health/chronic disease management**— We did not get the grant for Care Coordination/Chronic care from the MT Healthcare Foundation, but are going to consider developing this on our own anyways.
- **R&R of Human Capital** - We are pleased to announce the agreement with Shane Jensen, FNP as well as his wife Karyn who is an RN going to join our team/family in June. We have hired a locums Lab Tech who may become permanent. As well as advertising for a hskpg position and looking at positions in nursing on the floor and clinic
- **Access to Healthcare** - PCH continues to offer the 340B pharmacy program for under-insured/un-insured patients. Continue to explore options/opportunities for EMS ground transports to out of town facilities and are excited to start working with new EMS Coordinator
- **Partnerships/Collaborations** - Community conversations moving forward related to Suicide prevention, Community needs, Preparedness in partnership with LEPC. As well as PCH actively engaged in State/MHA initiative on Preventing Premature deaths. We still partner and are involved with the Hi-Line Technology group.
- **Reimbursement** —in conversations with VA Choice and Allegiance for MACO/MMIA
