4. More/others identified at the community PCH Annual/Strategic Planning meeting of 10/29/19
 - Continue work on financial viability and monitor/track VBP, care models and reimbursement
 - Initial planning for next CHNA
 - Continued R/R of quality, qualified staff and continued succession planning in all areas
 - Track/monitor technology and engage/implement as needed and appropriate – Telemed, other
 - Partnering with payers
 - Education/information to community about healthcare – all aspects – consumerism
 - Continue to partner, collaborate and communicate with other entities and organizations
